

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF THE CHEMICAL PRECURSORS TO METHAMPHETAMINE PRODUCTION, SUCH AS EPHEDRINE PRODUCTS AND PSEUDOEPHEDRINE PRODUCTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
{ _____ }, **OKLAHOMA**, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section I: Prohibition of sale/distribution of methamphetamine precursor drugs.

It shall be illegal for any person to sell, deliver, or distribute any ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, their salts their optical isomers, or salts of their optical isomers, without a valid prescription issued by a duly licensed physician, nurse practitioner or supervised physician's assistant and filled by an Oklahoma licensed pharmacist or pharmacy technician.

Nothing in this section shall prohibit the distribution of ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, their salts their optical isomers, or salts of their optical isomers by an Oklahoma licensed physician, nurse practitioner or physician's assistant within the physician's office, or any clinic, nursing home or other properly licensed healthcare facility upon the orders of said authority.

No prescription issued pursuant to this section shall be filled or refilled more than six (6) months after the date such prescription was issued, and no such prescription authorized to be refilled may be refilled more than five (5) times.

Section II:

This section shall not apply to any ephedrine, pseudoephedrine compounds, mixtures, or preparations which are in liquid, liquid capsule or gel capsule form.

Section III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section IV:

Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 and costs, or imprisonment not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both such fine and costs and imprisonment. A separate offense shall be deemed committee for each delivery, sale or distribution transaction.

Section V:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage and approval.
