*Around 2004 (last time numbers were calculated), approximately 81% of children removed from meth labs tested positive for meth.

Office of National Drug Control Policy wrote a letter to an Indiana representative regarding the cost of methamphetamine labs.

In his letter dated October 13, 2010, R. Gil Kerlikowske, Director of the Office of National Drug Control Policy, states "the combination of clean-up costs (\$3,500), law enforcement costs (\$5,000), court costs (\$5,000), incarceration costs (\$252,000), plus property damage, treatment, mental health, and child welfare costs, add up to an average estimate of \$350,000 per lab, once suspects are arrested." Using the data cited by the Office of National Drug Control Policy, the estimated cost of methamphetamine labs processed by the Tulsa Police Department over the years 2009-present would be:
